As our city begins to reopen and more gatherings are allowed, I want to announce that we will once again be accepting volunteers for our soup kitchen beginning on July 8. At this time, we will still only be open on Wednesday and Saturday mornings, but will look to add additional days soon.

For those of you who have volunteered before, there are some adaptations:

- All meals are “to go.” A table is set up outside where guests can take a bag of food, coffee and water. In cases of rain, the table is set up at the door to the kitchen.
- Masks and gloves must be worn at all times while volunteering.
- There will be only one lead volunteer and three other volunteers per shift.
- People over 65 are allowed to volunteer; however, we ask that you remain in the kitchen and not be outside monitoring the table.
