



The Church believes that parents are the primary educators of their children therefore St. Vincent de Paul offers the family catechetical religious education model (parents attend classes with their child(ren)).

Classes will still be held once a month on Sundays at 11:00 AM. Families will be expected to complete activities during the weeks classes are not held and attend (or virtually attend) Mass weekly.

Classes will begin in September. Until at least January 2020 all religious education instruction held through St. Vincent de Paul Parish will be held online.

This year families will be divided into three classes:

1. Students who have received First Communion (these students will receive the sacrament of Confirmation in spring 2022).
2. Students who have completed at least one year of religious education instruction. These students will be receiving their First Communion spring 2021.
3. Students who have not received their First Communion.

Please be aware that the Archdiocese of Chicago requires that all students complete two years of religious education classes prior to receiving their First Communion or Confirmation.

On the Sundays that classes are held you'll need to have access to Zoom. The Archdiocese is requiring that a parent/guardian be physically present with a child on all Zoom calls involving minors.
